January 18, members of the lakeshore prolife community came together for the 9th Annual Memorial for the Unborn in commemoration of the 47th anniversary of the Roe v. Wade decision that legalized abortion.

Participants assembled at First Reformed Church, where Pastor John Kenny offered a welcome, blessing over our group. Rev. Charles Schwartz called us to prayer and scripture with Psalm 29. Rev. Wayne Muri's message reminded us to remember the words of Winston Churchill..."We must never give in...never, never, never give in and never grow weary of the fight."

As is their annual tradition, all students present participated in the candle ceremony. Processing solemnly and silently from the rear of the church, the students carried forward memorial candles, each candle representing 10 of the 569 innocent unborn lives lost to

abortion last year in Ottawa and Muskegon Counties. Following the candle procession, Jeremiah Miller played 'Hope in the Fight' for our time of reflection. Give us gospel courage to contend against the dark oxymoron called "legal abortion".

We often have a built-in cultural mechanism when deciding for whom we will vote. However, a single issue often becomes the determining factor. As you cast your ballot, think about this; God creates all human life. God decides what gender all life is at conception. God has a plan for all of us. It's our job, with the help of

God, to figure that plan out. Sounds easy, but not all people believe this way. If God is not the Father of all life, who is? Some people feel that God has no place in life decisions.
